It provides the framework for a setting-wide review, considering approaches to high quality inclusion across curriculum, while ensuring all stakeholders have a voice.

This 2 day event welcomes education professionals from Post-16 provisions. It offers tools to reflect on the inclusive practice of your organisation, asking 'How well do you meet SEND needs?'

Programme

Focus is on the role of inclusion in the content and delivery of curriculum, both in provision and in practice.
