Approach

An Appreciative Inquiry approach promotes powerful action research, reflecting on personal, professional and organisational practice.

It provides the framework for a setting-wide review, considering approaches to high quality inclusion across curriculum, while ensuring all stakeholders have a voice.

This 2 day event welcomes education professionals from Post-16 provisions. It offers tools to reflect on the inclusive practice of your organisation, asking 'How well do you meet SEND needs?'

Ideally 2 people from the same Organisation attend to support change and implementation of AI after the session.
